### 2005 Ministry Accomplishments



**I would like to give praise to our wonderful Lord and Savior who has allowed this Ministry to be the instrument used in over 100 professions of faith in 2005.**

- We currently have 8 men who have been trained/mentored or we enlisted to help each month at either Nursing Homes/Assisted Living and/or Correctional Facilities.
- Continue to multiply and expand the Kingdom and our ministry by training/mentoring men who can preach and teach in either Nursing Homes/Assisted Living /Correctional Facilities
- Full time ministry for over 2 years
- On Mission in Correctional Facilities for 7 ½ years and Nursing Homes/Assisted Living for 6
- At least 100 professions of faith so far in 2005
- Regular volunteers from 7 different churches
- Provide 278 Correctional Services a year
- Provide 108 Nursing Home/Assisted Living Services a year
- Provide a total of at least 386 Services a year, plus special programs and preaching at churches
- Conducted a program in June at Sav. Men's Transitional Center with a 32 member mission group consisting of 4 churches from Summerhill Assoc. in GA. Had one profession of faith
- Gave Mother's Day Cards to Residents and Staff at Savannah Specialty Care, also gave out Corsages to all Mothers at 5 other Nursing Home/Assisted Living Facilities
- Started handing out 12 step booklets with How to Find a Job, Job Tips, Job Contacts for the Savannah Area, Family relations, and Grant information at our weekly Substance Abuse Program at Coastal Men's Transitional Center
- Gave 5 wheelchairs to 2 Nursing Homes for the patients who did not have one to use
- Started an email devotional, if you would like to receive these, <mailto:marty@hisloveministries.net> and put devotional in the subject.
- Preached 3 Sundays at Victory Baptist in June
- Filled in 2 Weds. Night Services at First Baptist Church of the Islands and Preached July 3rd
- Handed out 52 Bibles this year
- Conduct Services at all 5 Correctional Facilities in our immediate area

## His Love Ministries Nursing Home, Jail, and Prison Schedule

**We provide 31 services a month Nursing Homes/Assisted Living / Correctional Facilities (386 a year as of March 2005), plus Marty fills in as a supply preacher and special speaker for groups as he gets the opportunity.**

*His Love Ministries does not charge, nor are we paid for any of the services we provide at facilities. We are a full-time non-profit 501(c) 3 ministry organization that is funded by churches, individuals, and businesses who share our vision and are willing to help us reach out to those the world has forgotten.*

**We currently have 8 men who have been trained/mentored or who help each month at either Nursing Homes/Assisted Living and/or Correctional Facilities. One of our desires is to train/mentor and find men and women who will help us expand our outreach into every Nursing Home/Assisted Living/Correctional Facility in our area and beyond.**
