119 of those saved this year have been in the jail, prison, and transitional center.

- ✂ Partnered with First Baptist of the Islands to put on a Easter Program at the Transitional Center
- ✂ I have seen two men this year come out of the grips of Islam and into the Christian faith. One man wanted to know if God could still use him since he had been deceived. I told him yes. He has sent some of his relative's materials that would point them towards Christ because they have been deceived also. The other man came to understand the truth about Christ and is determined to make it on the outside. He has since been released, so pray for Leon.
