Dear Marty,

I just wanted to drop you a note thanking you for being so kind to B. He told me you took him with you the other night, and seemed happy to be able to help you set up for your meeting, and appreciated your offer to help with his needs at Walmart. I'm glad B heard a clear presentation of the gospel. Thank you soooooo much - it's more than his own father has done for him. B needs more than just having money thrown at him (what his dad did before). I talked with him tonight, - he's worked the last couple of days, and didn't seem to get any grief from the guy who runs the place. We hope and pray he can eventually work his way out of there. We sent him some gift certificates from Burger King and McDonalds, and today I went to the store and bought some toiletries to send to him. I hope he doesn't get discouraged and just hangs in there. We're praying so much that God will take hold in his life- I feel like it's a true battle for his soul. I really appreciate your calling me last night to let me know his whereabouts, and also appreciate your involvement. So few people today seem to care what happens to ex-offenders. God has truly given you a mission in life (and not an easy one), but He's with you all the way. I'm sure it has to be rewarding to see those become saved. Everyone has worth - one just has to dig a little deeper with some. Thank you again for your help with B, you and I are the only support system he has. I do believe he's trying for the first time in his life to make a life for himself. I continue to pray that he will see God's love through the assistance he's being given and that God will soften his heart. We just want B to have a chance at living a normal life without being a slave to alcohol or any other addiction. In my heart I know God has His Hand on him.

2005 Ministry Accomplishments



I would especially like to thank all those who have volunteered and given this past year. You have made all this possible through your gifts of time and money. God Bless All of You.

I would like to give praise to our wonderful Lord and Savior who has allowed this Ministry to be the instrument used in at least 330 professions of faith in 2005.

I believe we had as many or more professions of faith in 2005, as we did in 2004. I say this because many times at the prison or jail we did not get to give an invitation, because we had to end the service early.

- On Mission since December 1997
- 111 professions of faith so far in 2006
- 330 professions of faith in 2005
- 403 professions of faith in 2004
- 281 professions of faith in 2003
- 52 professions of faith in 2002
- Provided 278 Correctional Services last year at 5 different facilities
- Provided 120 Nursing Home/Assisted Living Services last year at 7 facilities
- Provided a total of at least 398 Services last year, plus special programs to over 7,061 people
- Preached 18 times at 8 different Churches last year
- Gave out around 300 Christmas Cards to Inmates at Correctional Facilities, Nursing Homes, and Assisted Living Facilities
- Provided Christmas Presents to 27 Nursing Home Residents who have no family at 6 different facilities
- Conducted Christmas Programs at Coastal & Savannah Men's Transition Centers (8 Saved)
- Handed out about 60 Bibles this past year
- Have an ongoing weekly Substance Abuse Program at Coastal Men's Transitional Center
- Currently have 8 men who have been trained/mentored or we enlisted to help each month at either Nursing Homes/Assisted Living and/or Correctional Facilities.
- Continue to multiply and expand the Kingdom and our ministry by training & mentoring men who can preach and teach
- Began giving Birthday Cards & started an adopt a resident program at 3 Nursing Homes
- Since August 2005, I have worked with a man, who had just gotten out of prison to help him get a place to stay, a job, and share the Gospel with him.
